Dear Governor Walz:

Thank you for allowing me to offer my application for membership on the Minnesota State Arts Board.

During my legislative career I took pride in many of the issues in which I was involved, but I believe that I played an important role in the enhancement and success of public support for the arts in Minnesota. And, my Minnesota activity also led to service in several national capacities as well.

I began my legislative activities relative to the arts in my first year in the State Senate. I founded the Legislative Arts Caucus to enhance the understanding my colleagues in the Senate and the House of the importance of the arts in Minnesota. In addition to local arts leaders and organizations we brought in national figures like Isaac Stern and August Wilson. I than in my first finance chairmanship provided significant general fund increases to the Arts Board and especially in partnership with Governor Carlson in 1997.

Later, during my chairmanship of the Senate Finance Committee the Legacy Amendment passed the Senate and subsequent to that passed the entire Legislature when it was than placed on the general election ballot. In particular, I am proud of the establishment of the Arts and Cultural Fund as part of the Legacy Amendment and within the fund the dedication of the access grants allowing support for historically underserved communities with the arts in the state. Additionally, in addition to chairing the Finance Committee, I also chaired the Legacy Subcommittee.

However, I seek this appointment not simply because of what I might have done in the past, but because I feel that I can provide leadership on the Board at a difficult time. For the first time in decades there are some fissures developing within the arts community, and this is especially troublesome with the need to begin work on the re-authorization of the Amendment. I hope that my knowledge of the arts in Minnesota as well my reputation throughout the state might be of help and leadership on the Board.
