To Whom It May Concern:

I am interested in serving as the Congressional District 7 public board member on the MN EQB. As someone who teaches a course on environmental politics and who is deeply involved in environmental, climate, and community resilience issues at the local level, I have long appreciated the work of the EQB. My former colleague Gerry Van Amberg approached me some years ago about possible service, but circumstances at the time did not allow me to pursue this. A week ago, Moorhead Mayor Shelly Carlson contacted me to tell me about the vacancy and to say that she and District Judge Johnathan Judd hoped that I would apply. The timing is perfect, and I am eager to contribute to the important work of the EQB.

The Environmental Quality Board's mission aligns well with what has driven me in my recent work with students and in my community of Moorhead: a passion for bringing people together to appreciate the importance of working to preserve and foster healthy ecosystems and environmental health that supports human thriving. Overcoming political polarization around environmental through meaningful public engagement is a particular interest of mine and led me to organize events at Concordia that showcased conservatives who favor strong climate action and to become involved with the depolarization organization Braver Angels.

In my own community, I created (along with a colleagues) the Moorhead Community Resilience Task Force with the aim of taking action to make Moorhead better prepared to thrive amidst the impacts of climate change. Working with the 21 organizational stakeholders, including the City of Moorhead, has taught me much about the opportunities we have for positive action that can garner wide support. My work leading the task force is an extension of my role as a professor of political science who teaches courses on environmental politics, climate change, and sustainable development. Helping students to understand and appreciate the complexities of environmental policymaking and implementation – and to see how they can be involved – is particularly rewarding to me.

I possess the skills, temperament, and dedication needed to be a thoughtful and effective member of the Environmental Quality Board. As a board member, I would be a learner who promotes collaborative approaches and strategic thinking. Thank you for considering my application.
