1.8 **WHEREAS**, the top-ranked Hornets, with scores of 37.725 on the floor, 37.075 on the vault,

1.9 35.800 on the uneven bars, and 37.050 on the balance beam, defeated the second-place Detroit

1.10 Lakes Lakers 147.650-146.150 in an exciting and highly competitive finish to win the state
